From the Executive Director's Desk

Greetings,

When the weather outside is frightful, our children can still enjoy a safe, healthy winter. Keep these school reminders handy!

Fend off cold and flu all winter long

Now that winter is upon us, it is the time of year that can be challenging to keep our children healthy. A few proactive steps can help our SPM staff and parents work together to achieve a healthy school environment.

Keep germs at bay...

We disinfect tables and play surfaces several times a day. We always have the children wash their hands before eating and after toileting.

Experts cites two useful tips to help children avoid spreading germs:

• Wash your hands for the right amount of time, and in the right way, to help get rid of germs. Have your child to rub his or her hands vigorously with soap and warm water for 20 seconds (about the time

it takes to sing the "Birthday Song")

• Cover coughs. Because few people wash their hands after they cough into them, nurses suggest that children cough into their inner elbow instead of their hands.

What if your child is sick...

When your child goes home sick, you will be asked to sign our Sick Child Policy. As a reminder, this policy states the following:

• Each week we must report all contagious disease to the City of Detroit Health Department.

• Children sent home with a fever, vomiting, and/or diarrhea may <u>not</u> return the next day. They must be fever free and free from these symptoms for at least 24 hours.

• We cannot accept a child for care if he or she recently vomited, or has a fever or has profuse nasal discharge.
